Please note the following criteria for the selection of our cultural grantees:

- a. Interest in the study, perpetuation and promotion of Okinawan culture, language and/or history,
- b. Leadership ability,
- c. Community service,
- d. Acceptance to study under a recognized instructor of Okinawan culture, language, and/or history,
- e. Participation in a program for the promotion and perpetuation of Okinawan culture
- f. Financial need,
- g. Overall potential for success,
- h. Clarity of goal(s),
- i. Two letters of recommendation from individuals other than relatives;
- j. Monies cannot be used for purchase of costumes, equipment and supplies for personal use. The club or organization applying for the grant shall retain ownership of said costumes, equipment and/or supplies.
- k. All prospective grant projects/activities should take place from January through December (of the grant year), and recipients of this Grant must expend their money within that calendar year;
- l. Failure by a grantee to submit a Summary Report by March 31 of the year following the grant year will impact future applications.
